

Team Selection Process

1. Returning players may return to the team they played for in the prior season if they wish. If an assistant coach inherits a team and becomes a head coach, then the player would return to that team.
2. To be able to return to their previous team, a player must have been registered prior to the coaches look.
3. Players returning to the same team will not participate in the coach's look and draft.
4. Players that do not wish to return to their previous team will need to attend coach's look and be drafted. An email will need to be sent to the commissioner for this request.
5. New players, or players that were on a team that moved up or was dissolved, will need to attend the coaches look.
6. A player that has played for a team in the season before the latest season (no longer than 12 months ago) may return to that previous team (if they wish) under the following conditions:
 - a. The team has an available roster spot
 - b. The most recent coach agrees (the most recent head coach has precedent.)
7. Siblings will go with a sibling, unless requested not to by the parents
8. Players that do not participate in the coach's look will be placed in a blind draft.
9. Players that are registered after the draft will be placed on the team that would have been next in the draft
10. Exceptions to the rules will be allowed with unanimous consent from coaches in that division
11. League commissioner reserves the right to deviate as needed to ensure equitable player distribution

Draft Rules

1. Draft order will be chosen by random draw.
2. The coach with the first pick in each round will be last in the next. Each coach will subsequently move up a spot with each round.

Example

- a. Round 1: A, B, C, C, B, A
 - b. Round 2: B, C, A, A, C, B
 - c. Round 3: C, A, B, B, A, C
3. Teams not having equal number of protected players or roster spots will receive an additional draft selection in the middle of each round until teams have an equal number of players.

Fall 2014 15U Exception:

In the 15U age division, teams will be allowed to protect 7 players, which will include coach's daughters.
