

Lightning Safety/Weather Protocall

HSA Baseball Commissioner will utilize the phone app “Lightning” to determine if lightning has been detected within 10 miles of the Fire Station Fields.

Once an alert has been identified, all fields/dugouts are to be cleared. Parents may take children to cars or "hang out" in the parking lot.

After 30 minutes, assuming there is no additional lightning activity, the Baseball Commissioner will give the "all clear" message to the Head Coaches. At this time players/coaches may take the fields and games may resume.

If lightning strikes during the 30-minute delay the time will be extended. (example: 10 minutes into a 30 minute delay we have another strike of lightning detected then the clock will start over and your delay will be a total of 40 minutes)

If you are scheduled to arrive at the Fire Station Fields for early games please monitor communication from your Head Coach to see if we are in our 30 minute delay time. The information may have been communicated prior to the start of games.

Games that are delayed for more than 45min will not resume on the day of.

If a game is unable to resume, and has completed 3 full innings, the game will be marked as complete, and the score will be finalized. If the game was tied, the final score will be left as a tie.

If a game has not completed 3 full innings, it will resume on a different date.
